

Trail Expansion 2016
Thanks to the wonderful, dedicated volunteers and donated equipment and expertise, the snowmaking trail expansion of Tail End and Magic Carpet Ride finally has been completed.
An aerial view shows the new area in which pipe and hydrants have been

installed. Total cost is not yet calculated as reseeding and other landscaping needs to be completed. Thanks to the donations for Trail Expansion that totaled over \$50,000 this campaign year, the expansion will be fully funded; money is left over for the next phase of the snowmaking project.
