- We decided not to proceed with a "do not walk on the groomed trail" sign. Formally we will let the DNR enforce that rule.
- Anne will explore with the DNR, as opportunity allows, how to be more collaborative. Possibly exploring how to have designated contact persons who would form a "grooming committee" that would be spokespersons for the skiing community. All with the aim of having a more thoughtful and deliberate approach to communication between the skiing community and the DNR staff regarding snowmaking and grooming.
- -Drainage has been improved as a result of well-placed culverts.
- We agreed to go have Angie Lorbach head up Fright Hike again for the weekend of Oct 11th-12th.
- -John McCarthy will proceed with the grant application to the David & Joyce Weizenicker Endowment Fund for State Parks.
